



Dos Picos County Park

ACCESS: From Hwy 67 in Ramona, exit at the sign for Dos Picos Park and Mussey Grade Road. Continue 1.1 miles on Mussey Grade Road. Right on Dos Picos Park Road. Park entrance is another 0.6 mile.

LENGTH AND ELEVATION: Nature trail length is about 0.5 mile; 1506'.

DESCRIPTION: Dos Picos, meaning "two peaks," was designed for campers and picnickers (horses and bicycling not permitted). Each campsite and picnic bench has been fitted into the 78-acre, oak-dotted area as naturally as possible. Available for overnight stays are 62 campsites (including tent sites and RV sites with partial hookups to electricity and piped water) and a caravan (group) area. The facilities include flush toilets, hot showers, and laundry tubs. Tables and fire rings are at most sites. Due to the fire hazard, fires are permitted if permission is granted from the ranger. If desired, firewood must either be brought in or the ranger generally has a supply for sale. A holding tank disposal station is available for free. There is a large group picnic area with 195 tables. There is no fee to picnic, but there is a \$2.00 parking fee. There is also a large barbecue, dance pavillion, and serving counter. Visitors are invited to enjoy the self-guided nature trail, horseshoe pits, two play areas, pond, and soccer field. Fishing is available at nearby San Vicente Reservoir. Hikers often visit nearby Mt. Woodson.
